Texas sells \$27.0 billion in goods and services to Canada alone, and 460,000 jobs in Texas depend on trade and investment with Canada. Maintaining this important trading relationship is vital to economic growth and job creation for both Texas and Canada, and with the U.S.-Mexico-Canada Agreement requiring ratification by all three countries, it is an optimal time to discuss this important topic. Conference attendees will hear discussions on topics of global relations and leadership, the latest developments in trade, and the impact this issue has on our communities and economies back home.
